


Georgia blueberry commercial industry

• Southern highbush (Vaccinium hybrids)








Commercial blueberry variety needs

- No tearing or leakage from berry
- Sized for packing
- Taste ????

- Protracted ripening
- Flavorful
- Easy harvesting
- Attractive and/or novel plant
- Adapted to area
