Cowboy™ Perennial Peanut

- *Arachis glabrata*
- Narrow green leaves
- Low growing
- Vegetatively propagated (rhizomes or sod)
- Ornamental, but could be used for grazing/hay.
- Potential for ground cover in orchards.
- Cowboy™ perennial peanut fixes atmospheric nitrogen (legume).
- Flowers from May thru Sept.
