- 8:05 am Brian Schwartz (UGA) <u>Developing New Turfgrasses at the University of Georgia</u> An update will be given on the development and testing of new bermudagrasses, zoysiagrasses, and centipedegrasses for home lawns, sports fields, and golf courses.

We will briefly discuss some of the causes of bee decline and measures all pest managers need to take to protect pollinators during pest control.

The University of Georgia has been breeding new muscadine cultivars for over 100 years, and has vastly improved the quality of this fruit.
